



<u>Interim Budget - 2019</u>

Council reviewed and approved the 2019 budget.

Recreation Cost Sharing

Counci8l approved the 2019 proposed Budget for the Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Services Areas of Mutual Benefit to Rural and Urban Resident in the amount of \$197,737.00 and have forwarded it on to Leduc County for their approval.

Bylaw #160/18

Council reviewed, discussed and approved Bylaw #160/18 cited as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer Bylaw.

Emerging Trends 2019

Council authorized the attendance of Council members and the Municipal Administrator for the 2019 Emerging Trends Seminar.

Asset Management Program

Council approved the participation of staff in the Asset Management Cohort Programs to advance our asset management programs and commits to financial support towards the cost of this initiative for staff travel and accommodation.

Street Light - Upgrade

Council approved street light upgrades in the amount of \$37,794.52 plus the addition of a light installed near the intersection of 51 Avenue and 49 Street.

Business License Renewals

Please be advised that, as per Village of Warburg Bylaw #8/96, any person or persons operating a business or providing goods or services to the residents of the Village of Warburg must hold a current Business License. If you are supplying goods or services or if you anticipate supplying either to Village of Warburg residents or if you are contracted to perform work for the Village of Warburg, you must first obtain a current, valid Village of Warburg Business License. A Business License covers the calendar year of January 1 to December 31. The cost of such license is \$25/year/business for Home Based Businesses and Businesses located within the Village, and \$50 for businesses located outside the Village, Hawkers/Peddlers and Single Projects. Please also note that the 39/20 Alliance allows for any business residing in one of the 4 municipalities within the Alliance (Breton, Calmar, Thorsby and Warburg) to purchase a Regional Business License from your residing community for an additional \$50, allowing you to do business in the other municipalities without having to purchase separate licenses for every one.


