





# Experiencing signs of a heart attack?

Thousands of Canadians die from heart attacks each year. Recognize the signs. Act quickly. You could save a life.

#### 1. Call 9-1-1

Or your local emergency number Immediately. Emergency personnel can start treatment enroute to the hospital.

# 3. Take your nitroglycerin

If you take nitroglycerin, take your normal dosage.

#### 5. Rest and wait

Stay calm while waiting for help to arrive.

### 2. Stop all activity

Sit or lie down, in whatever position is most comfortable.

# 4. Take ASA (Aspirin)

Chew and swallow ASA (Aspirin), if you are not allergic or intolerant (either one 325 mg tablet or two 81 mg tablets).

#### 6. Keep a list of your medications in your wallet and by the phone.

Emergency personnel will want this information.



#### Sale of 2004 GMC Sierra C3500 Truck

Council approved that the Village sell the 2004 GMC Sierra C3500 Truck at the next Ritchie Brothers sale in February 2024.

#### Cost Contribution (Arena Renovation)

#### Air Compressor
