- Campers must register upon arrival by calling 780-983-9287 (camp host).
- If required self-registration is available, near Sani-dump Station. Registration must include:
  - Name; Address; Vehicle License Plate Number; Phone Number; Number of persons in party.
     Caretaker will visit the site daily.
  - Other methods of payment include e-transfers to office@warburg.ca
- Check out time is 12:00 noon.
- Visitors Site visitors are welcome but must leave the campground by 11 pm.
- Site Holders are personally responsible for campsite cleanliness and condition as well as guest conduct.
- Washrooms Access is controlled by a punch code, which is currently \_\_\_\_\_\_. This code will be
  updated regularly and provided to registered campers. If the code does not work, please contact the RV
  Park Caretaker for assistance.
- Speed Limit 10 km/hr.
- Quiet Hours 11:00 pm 7:00 am, daily.
- Parking allowed only on parking pad.
- Campfires are allowed in designated fire rings only. Campers must obey all fire bans.
- Firewood burn clean firewood only, no nails or screws, no pallets.
- Vegetation- no cutting of vegetation.
- Banned/Prohibited No fireworks or firearms, no chainsaws, no motorized tools, no ATV, dirt bikes or horses.
- Generators limited used between 10:00 am and 7:00 pm, daily.
- Alcohol is prohibited outside of designate sites.
- Guardian Accompaniment anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Pets must be leashed, quiet and cleaned up after at all times.
- All garbage must be deposited in garbage containers and not burned in the fire pit.
- No sewage or grey water is to be discharged on the ground.

The Village of Warburg and Management is not responsible for personal injury, damage to property or lost or stolen items.
