

Home Alone: Parent & Child

Do you think your child is ready to start staying home alone occasionally for short periods of time? Does your child have some experience being home alone? No matter what your situation, this workshop will enhance your child's skill and confidence to stay home alone while giving you the knowledge about what your child needs in order to be ready.

This workshop focuses on home alone skills and readiness, as well as emergencies, back up plans and scenario practices. Children must be a minimum of nine years old to attend. A parent or caregiver must be in attendance.

Your Rights as a Tenant

Join a volunteer lawyer from Edmonton Community Legal Centre who will provide an overview of tenant rights and responsibilities under Alberta's Residential Tenancies Act. The session also highlights where to get help and how to take action if your rights are violated.

ECLC provides support in the areas of civil, including for residential tenancy disputes, family, immigration, and social benefits law.

Financial Empowerment Program

Leduc County Family and Community Support Service's (FCSS) Financial Empowerment Program allows you to explore how you can pay your bills, manage your debt, afford basic necessities and get ahead.

The program is free and confidential. Trained staff are here to listen and learn about what is important to you, offer you options and provide information based on your needs and interests. You take the lead and set the pace. Your knowledge and living experience is unique to you.

One-to-one sessions are available to help you:

- Learn about the subsidies, grants, benefits and supports that may be available to you.
- · Identify the financial challenges that are holding you back.
- Create action plans to meet your goals.
- Access the right support and services with helpful referrals to community agencies that provide specialized financial information and support.
- Increase your basic money management skills so that you can reduce debt, grow savings, build assets and make informed financial decisions.



Belonging is feeling accepted and valued by other individuals or groups. When we feel like we belong, it's good for our mental health. Having hobbies, interests, or activities can connect you to others. Do you have the same beliefs and values as others? Having shared identity, like religion, culture, and traditions can connect you with others. Participating in recreational activities or having interests like art or cooking can be a way to find connection. Finding commonality with others can help us to feel a sense of belonging and can contribute to long-lasting relationships. It can prevent loneliness and depression and provide opportunities for support through difficult times.

To increase your sense of belonging, engage with others who share your interests. It takes time and effort to build relationships. Be patient with the process and always be yourself!





June 9th, 2025 Council Meeting

Warburg Car/Truck Wash & Bottle Depot

Council approved the change to the assessment on Roll #447 as recommended by Powers & associates Appraisal Services Inc.

FORTIS Invite to Ponoka Stampede

Council approved that Administrator Pankewitz be authorized to accept the invite from FORTIS to attend the Ponoka Stampede on June 26th.

Armour Floor Coating—Repair Rubber

Council approved the quote from Armour Floor Coating to repair the rubber at the Community Park and boulevard on 50th Avenue and that the Village pursue the insurance reimbursement for the burn vehicle at the boulevard location.

Facilities Joint Use Agreement
