Waste & Recycling RFP

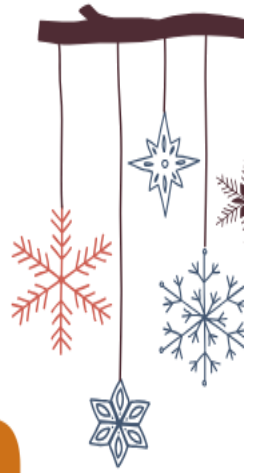
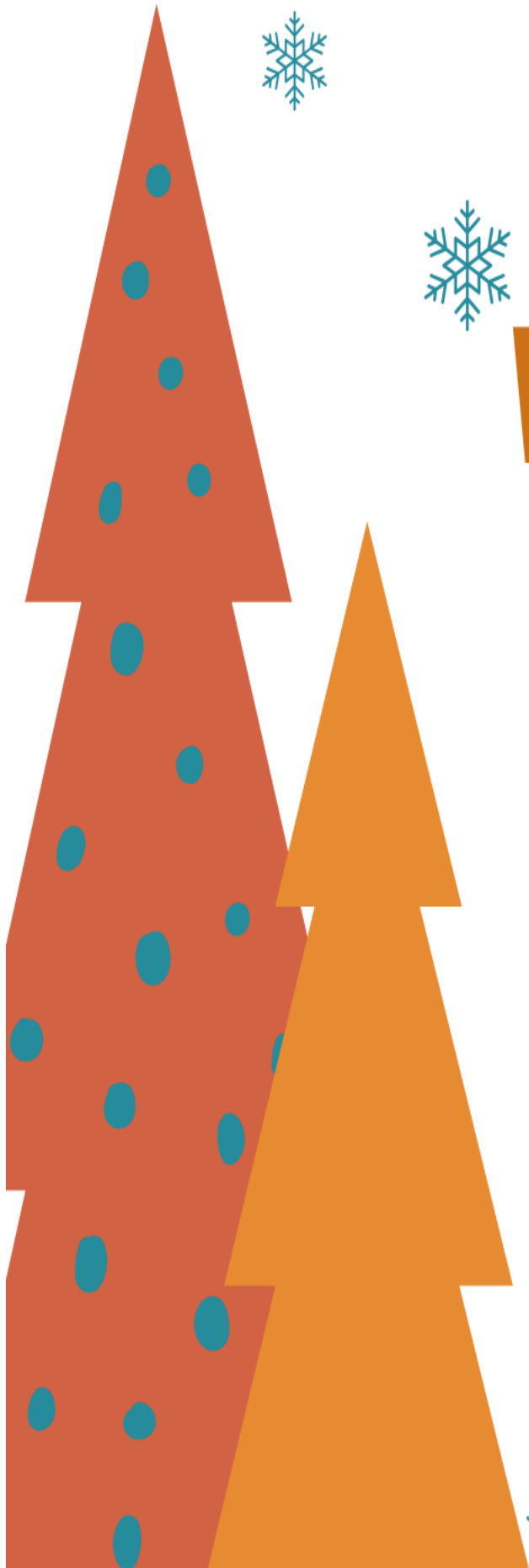
