## Village of Warburg Bylaw # 210/25

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF WARBURG, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE A DESIGNATED OFFICER TO CONSOLIDATE BYLAWS.

WHEREAS, Section 69(1) of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, provides that a council may by bylaw authorize a designated officer to consolidate one or more bylaws of the municipality by incorporating all amendments to them into a single bylaw;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Warburg deems it in the best interests of the municipality to authorize a designated officer to consolidate bylaws for ease of reference and administration;

**NOW THEREFORE** UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE Municipal Government Act, the Council of the Village of Warburg, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

### PART 1 - TITLE

1.1 This Bylaw may be cited as the "Consolidation Bylaw".

### PART 2 - DESIGNATED OFFICER AUTHORITY

- 2.1 The Chief Administrative Officer (CAO), or a designated officer assigned by the CAO, is hereby authorized to consolidate one or more bylaws of the Village of Warburg by incorporating all approved amendments into a single bylaw.
- 2.2 A consolidated bylaw prepared under this authority must clearly state in the bylaw header that it is a "consolidated version" and must identify the original bylaw number and all amending bylaw numbers included in the consolidation.

# PART 3 - CERTIFICATION AND RECORD KEEPING

- 3.1 Each consolidated bylaw must contain a statement certifying that it is a consolidation of the original bylaw and all amendments thereto.
- 3.2 The CAO or designated officer shall maintain a record of the original signed bylaws and all amendments as adopted by Council.

## **PART 4 - LIMITATIONS**

- 4.1 Consolidation under this bylaw is for reference purposes only and does not change the substance of the bylaw as approved by Council.
- 4.2 In the event of a discrepancy between a consolidated bylaw and the original bylaw and amendments, the original bylaw and amendments shall prevail.

## **PART 5 - ENACTMENT**

5.1 This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon third and final reading thereof. Read a first time this 14th day of October, A.D. 2025.

Read a second time this 14th day of October, A.D. 2025.

Read a third time and finally and unanimously passed this  $14^{th}$  day of October, A.D. 2025.
