Village of Warburg Bylaw # 208/25

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF WARBURG, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND THE WARBURG MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN BYLAW 172/20.

PURSUANT to part 17 of the *Municipal Government Act* the Council of the Village of Warburg enacts the following amendment to Bylaw 172/20, the Warburg Municipal Development Plan Bylaw:

 Schedule "A" of Bylaw 172/20, Warburg Municipal Development Plan, is hereby amended by adding the following immediately after Section 6 Policies under Part 3 – Setting the Stage for Growth:

SECTION 6A | AGRICULTURAL POLICIES

- 6A.1 The Village recognizes the importance of agricultural operations within and adjacent to the municipal boundary as a valued component of the community and regional economy.
- 6A.2 The premature subdivision, fragmentation, or conversion of agricultural land for non-agricultural uses shall be discouraged until such lands are required for urban development consistent with the Municipal Development Plan.
- 6A.3 Where urban development is proposed adjacent to agricultural operations, the Village may require buffering, transitional land uses, or other appropriate measures to minimize land use conflicts.
- 6A.4 The Village will work with Leduc County and regional partners to coordinate planning and growth management policies that protect agricultural lands and operations.
- 6A.5 The Village will consider the impacts on agricultural operations when evaluating annexation, subdivision, or development proposals.
